Saints of the week :-

21st The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary According to tradition Mary was brought to the Temple as a child to be offered to the service of God. In the heavenly temple she presents our prayers to her Son, and through her intercession we hope one day to be presented to him in glory.

22nd St Cecilia was a Roman martyr in the 3rd century. She is the patroness of musicians and music.

23rd St. Columban (also known as Columbanus) was born around 543 and became a monk at Bangor where he became the principal teacher. In 591 he set out with 12 companions as a missionary in Europe and founded many monasteries on the strict Irish tradition. His most famous monastery is Bobbio where he died in 615. He is remembered as the greatest Irish missionary monk.

24th St. Andrew Dung Lac and his companions were 17th, 18th and 19th century martyrs in Vietnam. On 19th June 1988 Pope John Paul II canonized 96 native men and women as well as 10 Spanish Dominican missionaries and 11 French men.
