Wednesday 7th – St. Colman of Dromore, Co. Down
Friday 9th – St. Colmcille (Columba) Abbot and missionary. Secondary Patron of Ireland. Born in Donegal, he founded monasteries in Durrow, Derry and Lona in Scotland.
He died in 597.
