Newly Baptised : We welcome into the Christian Community Sé Eugene Donnelly, Ardaghy, Omeath.

This week's feasts : Tuesday 11th – St. Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe. He lived as a hermit before founding a monastery at Monte Cassino. He is responsible for writing the Rule which has guided Benedictines and Cistercian communities since then. His influence on Europe has been significant. In 1964 he was proclaimed Patron of Europe.

Friday 14th – St. Camillus de Lellis. Born in Naples, he began life as a soldier and set about caring for those wounded in battle. He is patron saint of hospitals, of the medical profession and of the sick and dying.

Saturday 15th – St. Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church. A Franciscan saint and theologian of the thirteenth century.

Young Church – Children's corner :- Jesus began his teaching in his home town. The neighbours were astonished at the wisdom of his teaching., but they couldn't accept either his teaching or his miracles. Jesus was amazed at their lack of faith.
