Independent Commission for the Location of Victims’ Remains -- Appeal for Information.

In 1999 the Independent Commission for the Location of Victims’ Remains was set up to receive information in relation to the location of the remains of those colloquially known as “the disappeared” so that they might be returned to their families for Christian burial.

These are people who had been killed by paramilitary organizations and buried in secret. There were 14 in all. To date only five of these remains have been recovered.

The Commission is now appealing for anyone with any information in relation to these cases to contact it. Any information given to the commission will be treated as strictly confidential and may only be used to locate and identify the remains.
