Otría's Story

Many children in Malawi have experienced the pain of rejection through no fault of their own. When Otría and her two sisters lost their parents, their local community rejected them as no one wanted to take on the burden of three extra children. Despite this Otría was determined to keep her family together. She grows crops to feed her sisters and does piece work around the area which allows her to buy maize, but she finds its very difficult being an outcast in her own community.
