Supporting Christians in the Holy Land

Yousef Yakoub is a clerical student and sub-deacon of the Maronite Catholic Diocese of Haifa and the Holy Land in Isreal. He is studying for the priesthood in St. Patrick's College, Maynooth. Yousef will speak at Masses next weekend 21st/22nd June about the plight of Christians in the Holy Land, especially Christian families in Bethlehem.

The majority of the Christians in Bethlehem work in areas related to tourism and the organisation of pilgrimages, which is the main source of their economy. But since the breakout of the Intifada in September 2000, the presence of pilgrims in the country has declined by 95%. This has resulted in many families finding themselves without work. Many have emigrated.

After Masses, parishioners will have a opportunity to support families in Bethlehem by buying religious items made from olive wood by local craftsmen.
