Bishop Eugene Arthurs I.C.

Bishop Arthurs was a native of Keady, Co Armagh and a member of the Rosminian Congregation (Institute of Charity). He was the first bishop of Tanga, East Africa (1958-1970). He died as Parish Priest of Braid, Co. Antrim in 1978 and is buried in the Rosminian Cemetery at Calvary, Omeath.

To mark the 30th anniversary of his death a group of parishioners from Braid, led by Fr. John Burns, will celebrate Mass in St. Laurence's Church, Omeath on Saturday 26th July at 12.00 noon. Everyone welcome.
