Indulgences

1. From 12 o'clock noon on 1st Nov until midnight on 2nd Nov, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intention (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confessions may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st Nov.
2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th Nov.

Parish Reorganisation in Archdiocese of Armagh The official launch of the parish reorganisation process takes place this weekend. A pastoral letter from our Archbishop, Cardinal Sean Brady is being read at all Masses in the diocese. The process has three stages.

Stage 1: Clustering (Nov 2008 – June 2009).

Each parish will be brought into a cluster of parishes for the purpose of sharing resources.

Stage 2: Clusters in Partnership (Sept 2009 – June 2010).

Each cluster of parishes will work together on addressing such matters as:

- how many priests are to serve in each parish in the cluster
- what resources are to be allocated to the employment of lay leaders in the cluster
- the number of Masses to be celebrated at the weekend and on weekdays in the cluster

Stage 3: New Parish Ministries and Structures

From September 2010 it is planned to develop new ministries and structures to meet the needs of our time.
