If you paid a minimum of €250 to parish collections in the tax year, the parish can claim back tax on your contribution. It does not cost you anything. All you need to do is complete the Charity Form and return it to the Parochial House, The Parish applies for the tax refund. These letters usually go out to PAYE contributions in the autumn. The parish can claim only on contribution made by envelope.
