Carlingford and the Nine Years' War Lecture by Dr. Hiram Morgan on Friday 29th October at 7.00pm in Carlingford Heritage Centre. The Nine Years War was one of the most decisive in Irish history. The final defeat of O'Neill and his allies at Kinsale in 1603 signalled the end of the Gaelic order in Ireland was soon followed by the Plantation of Ulster. Hugh O'Neill – the Great O'Neill – led a federation of Irish chieftains against English rule fighting a war that lasted almost a decade. Many of the decisive battles in the war were fought in the region around Carlingford. Queen Elizabeth's general, Marshal Bagenal was based in Newry and control of Carlingford was vital to his security. A leading scholar on this period will tell us how the war went and what part Carlingford played in it.
