'Let there be no doubt that the killing of Ronan Kerr was totally unjustified. It was an evil deed, an offence against God and a complete rejection of the belief that human life is sacred.....

Parents and grandparents, I beg you, plead with your children and with your grandchildren, not to get involved with violence...Violence has nothing, absolutely nothing, to offer except misery and destruction. Choose life, I say, choose goodness, choose peace. That is what God is asking of you. That is what the people of all traditions have been saying to all of us, loud and clear, since the moment of Ronan's tragic death on Saturday last...In God's name stop – and stop now!' – Cardinal Sean Brady, Archbishop of Armagh.
