New Missal Next Sunday, 11th September, marks the beginning of the introduction of texts of the new translation of the Roman Missal, leading to the full use of the new edition of the Missal on the First Sunday of Advent, 27th November. The texts of the new edition of the Roman Missal are being introduced in two phases to assist both congregations and clergy adjust slowly to the new translations.

From next Sunday we will begin to use the new translations of the people's prayers and responses at Mass, all of which will be on the congregation cards provided.

These include: the people's response to the greeting by the priest, the Confiteor, the Gloria, the Creed, the acclamations for the Eucharistic Prayer, as well as the text for the invitation to Communion.

Parish Pastoral Council A new Parish Pastoral Council is to be formed during September/October. The process will involve a Parish Gathering in both Carlingford and Omeath, followed by 4 weekly Reflection Sessions. All parishioners will be invited and encouraged to take part.
